Welcome back to school; we hope that you had a lovely half term holiday. Spring is fast approaching and we will be taking every opportunity to spot signs of the weather warming up and new things growing just as much as all the children are.

#### Curriculum Overview



This term, we will learn all about animals from England and from other countries, using stories such as "Handa's Hen" and "What the Ladybird Heard". This is complemented by our trip to The Gordon Brown Centre where we meet farm animals, make scarecrows and



build dens in the woods.

We will observe the weather as it changes, learn about new life as we approach Easter and make links between longer days, warmer weather and new plants growing.

## Physical Education and Games

be able to read more of the library books - look for the little words that they can do!

Check in the yellow reading record for notes on what RWI group your child is in and how to support them with reading at home. Please keep their yellow reading record in their book bags with their Read Write Inc phonics work in school every day.
